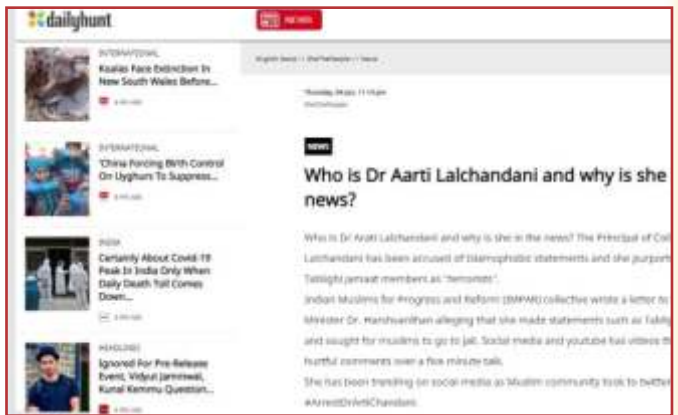

1. Issued guidelines as per SOP on preventive measures to contain spread of COVID 19 in religious places/places of worship.
2. IMPAR filed an RTI on the number of total deaths in the riots of North-East Delhi, FIR's for the missing people, total number of injured, list of houses and shops that were looted with list and names of affected families, list of burnt house and shops and names of affected families, list of the arrested people by names and the charges framed against each arrested person by name of police station or other concerned teams, list about the compensation that was paid for deaths, injured, burnt/damaged houses, properties etc.
3. IMPAR wrote letters of concern to Union Minister Dr Harshvardhan, MCI demanding action against the doctor who allegedly claimed that Tablighis are terrorists.
4. IMPAR managed to get Tableeghis released who were languishing in various quarantine centers across the country for many weeks. The COVID 19 protocols require 14 days of quarantine but, unfortunately, most of the Tableeghis had spent more than a month in quarantine. The irony was these people were quarantined for so many days, even when none of them found Corona positive. With the collective effort of few individuals such as Jb. MH Khan, IAS, ex-Secretary, GOI, Mr. HK Paliwal, ex Secy to CM, Zen Zameer Uddin Shah, and Mr MJ Khan around 250 Tabligh members were released who were lodged in Baraut for last 50 days. 55 Tablighis locked in quarantine in a school at a Gonda for 40 days were also released. Dr. Nitin Bansal, DM, helped in the completion all formalities and assured Tableeghis reached their home before Eid.
5. IMPAR had made a complaint with the National Human Rights Commission over the hunger death of the Tableeghi in hospital in Delhi. The complaint and has been picked up by the NHRC and it has sought response from concerned authorities failing which legal proceedings would be initiated against them.
6. IMPAR Political Group passed a resolution on political empowerment of the marginalised communities in a webinar. The webinar was convened by Mr Anis Ansari (retired IAS officer).
7. IMPAR released a press release regarding Zee Media demanding an impartial, unbiased, enquiry on the violation of Epidemic Act 1897 and lockdown 2.9 guidelines.
8. In the wake of the COVID 19 threat, IMPAR issued a set of guidelines for Eid 2020. The 11 points guidelines sought to ensure that social distancing and austerity measures were followed. In addition, to that IMPAR also urged people to offer Eid prayers at home, did no Eid shopping, avoided extravagant Eid meals and donated the money to needy irrespective of caste and creed.
9. IMPAR also coordinated with the Imams of various masjids across the country on giving directions about praying Eid namaz at home.
10. IMPAR initiated zakat related work for facilitating zakat collection for institutions which have not been able to go out and collect zakat this year. A list of Madrasas from across across the country was prepared. The list is uploaded on the IMPAR website.
11. Series of regular webinars were conducted by IMPAR.
12. The first webinar on Opportunity Start-ups post COVID 19 was conducted. Mr. Siraj Chaudhary, Mr MQ Sayed, Imteyaz Siddiqui, Dr Zubair, Ather Zia, John Rizvi, Mr MJ Khan were the eminent speakers for the occasion.
13. A webinar (2nd in series) on Fake News and Hate Speech: Consequences and recourse to Legal Remedies was conducted on 17 May 2020. Five speakers, Adv. Nasir Aziz, Adv. Firoze Ghazi, Adv. Ishtiaq Ali, Dr. Farukh Khan, and Adv. Tahir participated, and Sheeba Aslam Fahmi delivered the closing remark.
14. A webinar (3rd in series) on How Muslims view the Changing Political Scenario? was conducted on 21 May 2020. In the webinar key speakers were Mr. K. Rahman Khan, veteran Politician of Indian National Congress, former Union Minister of Minority Affairs and Ex-Deputy Chairman of Rajya Sabha and Mr. S M Shervani, Managing Director, Shervani group.
15. IMPAR sent a letter congratulating the Prime Minister for his statement that the virus has no religion.
16. IMPAR sent a letter to Mohan Bhagwat welcoming his statement that Muslims are an integral part of Indian society, and the whole community cannot be targeted for mistakes of few.
17. IMPAR sent a letter to the HM to take action against the hate messages targeting the Muslim community. IMPAR also sent another letter to HM to protest the students being arrested on false charges during the pandemic for inciting riots.
18. IMPAR sent a letter to secretary family health and welfare concerning the disturbing trend of Muslims facing discrimination in hospitals.
19. IMPAR sent letter of appreciation to Poorvanchal Dastak for serving the nation in the best possible way.
20. IMPAR letter of appreciation to go news for effective reporting.
21. IMPAR sent letter of appreciation to Mufti Rizwan Qasmi for his commendable role in the propagation of tolerance.
22. IMPAR has sent a letter of concern to DCP concerning sup moto action against the channels which played the doctored audio regarding Maulana Saad.
23. Wrote to Mr. Arvind Kejriwal for intervention in the cases of economic boycott that Muslim traders/vendors are undergoing.
24. Wrote to DCP against the instances of the economic boycott in several parts of Delhi, seeking immediate intervention.
25. Press release and reports about the First webinar were released.
26. Started a population bursting myth campaign on twitter.
27. Conducted a twitter storm on Eid at home.
28. IMPAR has managed to create a space get 300 plus best minds of the community together.
29. Working team has been put in place. Organizational structure laid with Steering Committee and working groups for more effective functioning.
30. Social Media and Mainstream Media Structure formulated.

31. All IMPAR social media handles operationalised, FB, LinkedIn, shared on social media. Twitter, Instagram, YouTube etc
32. IMPAR Brochure prepared and IMPAR website made functional.
33. Videos were generated about issues of importance and Social media team created and negotiations with agencies are underway.
34. TV programs were organized with panelists from IMPAR appearing for giving a progressive Muslim Perspective.
35. IMPAR was vastly covered by national and regional media.
36. Campaigns were launched and widely circulated, accepted and liked by general public
37. Letters were sent to CM'S congratulating them and pointing out lapses. Three Police complaints were filed and two legal petitions finalized.
38. IMPAR worked immensely hard to get a government formal advisory to media houses issued against hate speech and fake news. This advisory was issued to states and to regional media. Change in media discourse is visible.
39. Specific help was provided to stranded Muslims in 25 plus cases done using help and network of the members.
40. IMPAR urged the government to issue guidelines to FCI for opening its godowns for NGOs for direct lifting of stocks.
41. Food/ration deliveries were managed in about multiple cases by members plus Nafed supplies were arranged to one Muslim NGO in Mumbai.
42. Press releases were issued on specific subjects of concerns.
43. Twitter and Facebook handles have become more efficient with addition of members.
44. More than 5000 people joined through WhatsApp groups.
45. More than 30 Zoom meetings were held with various groups and Steering Committee.
46. Ramzan Guidelines were prepared and circulated in Media and Social Media in view of Covid-19 lockdown.
47. Appreciation letter was sent to Mr SonuSood for his remarkable contribution to the nation in the time of crisis.
48. IMPAR initiated a powerful campaign against Dr Aarti Lalchandani who had indulged in a hate rant against the Tablighis. In this regard, IMPAR wrote to Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare, Dr Harshvardhan and Medical Council of India asking for immediate action against the above-mentioned doctor. In addition to this, powerful media/social media campaign was launched by IMPAR against the purported hate speech by Dr. Aarti Lalchandani. Subsequently, IMPAR filed a Public Interest Litigation against Dr. Aarti Lalchandani in the Allahabad High Court.



49. Letters of concern were written to Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare, Dr Harshvardhan and Medical Council of India about how at certain places private hospital denied treatment to Muslims patients. It was requested that stern measures should be put in place to check this practice.

50. IMPAR filed a complaint with Delhi Commission for Women against Payal Rohatgi for her abusive tweets against Indian Muslim women.
51. A webinar was held on 10th June for the release of IMPAR website, launch of leadership development program, launch of IMPAR work plan, release of booklet on community work done during Covid19 and for sharing the progress report of the two month journey of IMPAR.



52. IMPAR held a meeting with its legal support group and discussed the cases of anti-CAA protestors on zoom meeting held on 14th .Subsequently a report about the meeting was also released.



53. IMPAR working agenda for next 12 months was released. The agenda touches issues of monitoring of media contents and constructive engagement, analyzing the social, political and economic challenges by internal working groups, constituting expert groups to leverage government programs and schemes, engaging with central and state governments and all the key institutions, reaching out to top 1000 corporate for CSR ,jobs and skill support, organizing meetings , expert lectures and roundtables with thought leaders of various subjects, holding dialogue with leaderships on all political parties, media and corporate houses, creating NGO's and start ups and

adopting the same number in existing districts, creating monitoring centre, emergency response team(ERT) with legal support system, organizing RRF(reward, recognition) function for outstanding community work, organizing social actions like cleanliness drive, feeding poor, community service and leadership of women and youth.



54. Articles about IMPAR were shared widely on social media handles and amongst the groups. The articles focused on the image and perceptions management of Muslims in India, organizing community reforms and positive social actions, creating channels of help for access to social and economic opportunities.

55. Press Release was issued urging mosques in Delhi and adjacent areas to remain shut in the month of June too. This was done following the spike in the COVID 19 cases in the Delhi-NCR

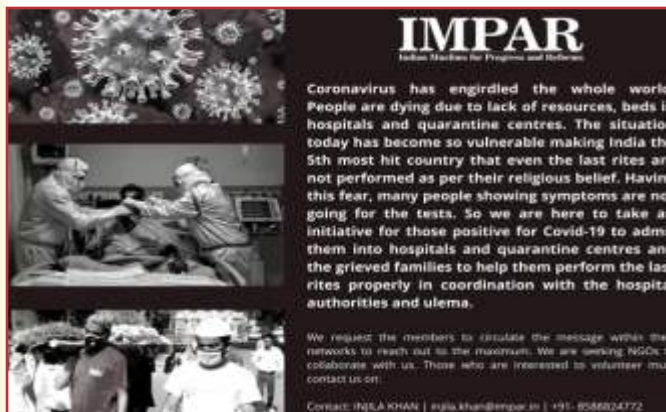
56. A campaign was done on Blood Donors Day. Since its impossible to have a blood donation camp in the current situation, IMPAR generated a web link where the donors could register themselves and could be contacted easily at the time of emergency.



57. In its endeavour to create jobs, IMPAR tied-up with HR company “Kaamhai” for helping youth who have been rendered jobless through the COVID 19 crisis and are unable to find right opportunities. IMPAR also collaborated with another HR company “Sodexo” for job creation. Several job advertisements were shared within the groups.



58. Another initiative taken by IMPAR was to collaborate with NGO's for admitting COVID19 patients in hospitals, quarantine centers and to provide help to the distressed families in performing their last rites.



59. IMPAR came out with a press release condemning the Chinese incursions in Ladakh and offered condolence to the families of 20 soldiers who lost their lives.
60. On World Environment Day, IMPAR convened a zoom interview with news channels.
61. IMPAR has filed a legal notice against news anchor Amish Devgan for making highly offensive, derogatory and defamatory remarks against revered Sufi Saint Hazrat Khwaja Moinuddin Chisti. Multiple FIRs are also registered. Notice has been sent to the channel by Diwan Associates on behalf of Khanqah Barkatia for slandering revered Sufi Saint Hazrat Khawaja Moinuddin Chisti.
62. IMPAR served legal notice to news anchor Shweta Singh and AajTak for insulting and questioning the courage of Indian Army. The notice has been sent by Diwan Associates.
63. IMPAR wrote to Shri Ajay Kumar Bhalla Home Secretary Government of India, Shri Ajit Doval National Security Advisor Government of India, Thiru K Palaniswami Honorable Chief Minister Government of Tamil Nadu Chennai, Mr K Shanmugan Chief Secretary Government of Tamil Nadu, H.E Banwari Lal Purohit, Hon'ble Governor of Tamil Nadu for the release of overseas Tableeghi Jamaati's languishing across various

Thousands of guests from across India and abroad had congregated at the international center of the Tablighi Jamaat known as the Banglewali Masjid in the Hazrat Nizamuddin area of Delhi. The series of global consultative meetings along with religious sermons had commenced and they were about to expand until the Prime Minister announced a sudden lockdown. Thousands of preachers from the country and abroad were staying in the Banglewali Masjid and due to total suspension of all means of transport including railways, air transport and road transport they had to stay in the Masjid.

Despite reports to the local police and repeated requests for cooperation, no solution for sending the preachers back to their homes was arrived at. As a result, in the next few days, unfortunately many preachers contracted Coronavirus.

Subsequently, our corrupt and bigoted media played a filthy game that makes the soul tremble at the thought of it. The best of God's servants were accused of sinisterly conspiring to spread this virus.

During this period a lot of important events which also contributed to the spread of the virus because of the negligence of the central government including the untimely arrival of the US President Donald Trump in Gujarat, the political game of Madhya Pradesh in which the Congress government was overthrown and a new BJP government was formed, presence of thousands of devotees in Vaishno Devi Temple were totally ignored by the media and only members of Tablighi Jamaat were vilified.

But now the Muslims of India have woken up from their slumber and they have become aware of the Sangh Parivar's tactics and conspiracies of the media. For the first time, Indian Muslims exhibited a strong sense of unity and strongly condemned the media's campaign of slander against the Tablighi Jamaat. Ignoring the hate campaign of the media, Muslims came forward to serve the needy with food, water, ration kits, medical supplies and even performed the last rites of the corpses of their Hindu brothers who had succumbed to Coronavirus. They did everything possible to help their fellow countrymen by all means necessary. After all, this is what Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) had taught the Muslims and they succeeded in proving that no matter what the circumstances, Muslims will always be in the frontline to serve the humanity in the hour of crisis.

It was not a long time after the vilification of Tablighi Jamaat that in a debate on June 15th, a sick and evil-minded anchor of News18, Amish Devgan, dishonored and disrespected the legendary Sufi Saint Hazret Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti Ajmeri and India once again witnessed the ideal unity of Muslims. Barelvis, Deobandis, Salafis, Shias, Khojas, Bohras all stood together and strongly condemned Amish Devgan and declared him a threat to the unity and integrity of the country. Multiple FIRs have been registered against him in several police stations of every state and this process is still going on.

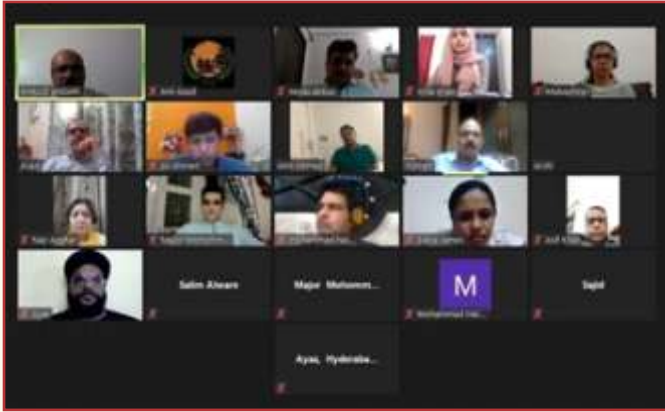

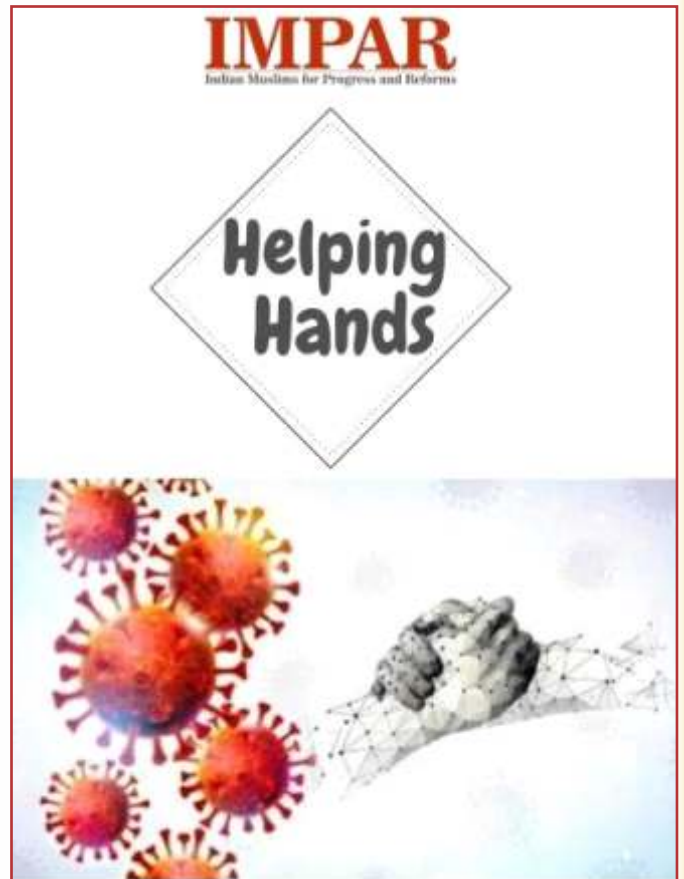

67. IMPAR also wrote to Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and ICMR for cancellation of licenses of laboratories who are involved in erroneous Covid 19 testing.

68. As part of the RRF, IMPAR plans to felicitate individuals and organisations who have done exemplary work in COVID19 Crisis (Helping Hands). Information about the program was disseminated and entries are being sought.



69. IMPAR is working towards the formation of District Action Groups (DAG's) across the districts. Work is being carried out on laying the structure and other necessary logistical arrangements.

70. IMPAR organised a webinar on Muslim Women in Higher education on 4 July 2020. Prof Arvinder Ansari-head of department Sociology JamiaMilliaIslamia, Ms Khair un Nissa Shah-Vice President World Trade Centre, Dr Amina Mirza-Assistant Professor Delhi University, Ms Sheeba Aslam Fehmi-journalist and India head at, Dr VenkateshSundaram -Economist at World Bank, Dr Arshia Sharif - Professor and Pharma consultant were the speakers for the event. More than 200 participants attended the webinar.

71. Discussions were initiated on Eid-ul-Azha guidelines.

72. District Action Groups were formed.

73. Sanitization and COVID 19 awareness drives were held in North-west Delhi by IMPAR volunteers.

Public Interest Litigation filed by IMPAR against Dr Arti Lal Chandani was heard by the division bench comprising of Hon'ble Chief Justice of Allahabad High Court and Hon'ble MR S D SINGH showing disagreement with the answer given by the state government and directed them to acquaint the court on 20th July 2020.

75. IMPAR initiated the knowledge series where it would be collecting thesis, books, documents, judicial reports about Muslim community in India.

that all the political parties must include Muslims concern for education, social and political empowerment into their working agenda to bring the community into mainstream.

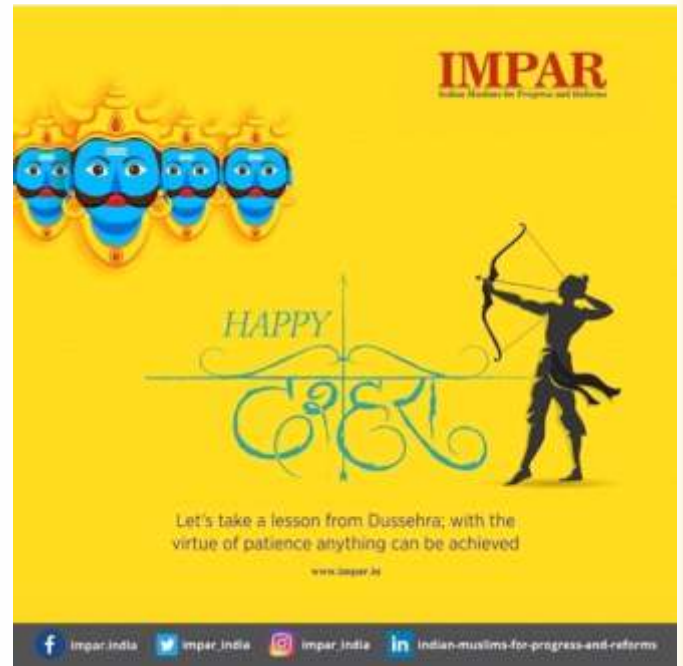

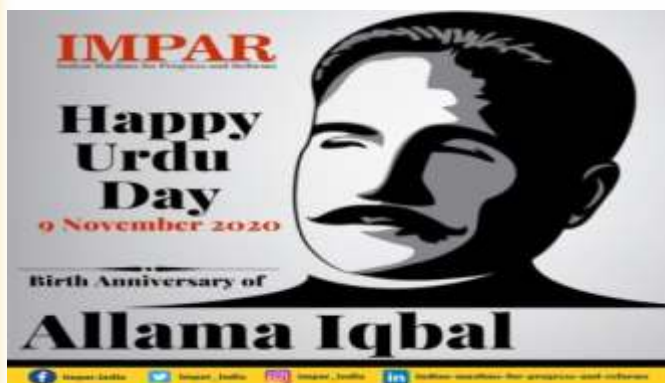

In its endeavour to establish channels of communication and engage with the administration and political leadership of the country, IMPAR wrote various letters of concern.

- A letter was written to Shri Prakash Javadekar, Cabinet Minister, Min. of Information and Broadcasting, Government of India on his Commendable Stand against Sudarshan News propagating hate against Muslims through four episodes of its "BindasBol" programme on alleged infiltration of Muslims in the bureaucracy which has breached the programme code and cautioned to the channel of "stricter penal action" in case of future violations.
- A letter was sent to Home Secretary, Government of India with the Request for putting a ban on the use of term 'Love Jihad' in legal and public discourse. The letter contented the fact that 'Love Jihad' itself is an undefined, unrecognized concept and no such case of 'love jihad' has been reported by any of the central agencies so far, highlighting Article 25 of the Constitution and said "it provided for the freedom to profess, practice and propagate religion subject to public order, morality and health".
- IMPAR has sent a greeting to The Chairman, National Dairy Development Board (NDDB) on National Milk Day being observed on November 26 every year with our eagerness to contribute with our available human and other resources in achieving the laid vision and mission of NDDV.
- A letter of appreciation was sent to Shri Mohan Bhagwat Ji, Sarsanghchak (Chief) of Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) on his remarks about 'World as a Family' in an online programme on 'Vaishwik Pridrishyamein Bharat ki Bhumika'.

## INDIAN ARMY: THE MOST SECULAR INSTITUTIONS IN THE COUNTRY

### COGNIZABLE HISTORY

It has been a widely held 'myth' that Indian Army institutionalizes religion or caste. There are some regiments in Indian Army named after communities, and some named after regions as determined by the British rulers then. But this has a historical context and has continued as an inherited legacy.

Thus, we have the Sikh regiment, the Marathas, the Jat, the Gorkhas etc. but this doesn't make any of these regiments exclusive for other communities or regions, like all other public institutions. So, it is no surprise to see a Mohammed Zaki commanding Garhwal troops or a Y N Sharma as commanding officer of the Grenadiers (which incidentally has Muslim soldiers) as head of the family, which is what a commanding officer is. It is common for a Zaki to felicitate the puja on Janmashtami, celebrating the birth of Lord Krishna, or for a Sharma to organise the namaz on Id Ul Fitr after Ramzan.

It is further emphasized that Indian Army has maintained a strong secular tradition and does not believe in religion based discrimination. To the extent that strong opposition was raised over the proposal for so called 'census' of Muslims in Indian Army. Several sections of Indian Army have also opposed the headcount on the basis of religion especially when the Sachar Panel had sought the data on Muslims share in Indian Army. Hence, there is no official report available in this regard. However, the strength of Muslim may be roughly around 2.50-3%, forming approximately 25-29000 personnel (CNN IBN).

It is undoubtedly true that the number of Muslims in the Army is far less than their proportion in the population. This is also a historical legacy as the recruitment of Muslims in the armed forces in pre-Independence India was concentrated in Punjab, North West Frontier and Balochistan which are all part of Pakistan today. Similarly, the states of Orissa, Gujarat or even Andhra Pradesh are not represented in proportion to their population. To assume any bias on regional basis is to see evil where none exists (Girish Palariya, 2019).

It is true that severe threats to amity and accord on account of divisive politics and the consequent weakening of the social fabric in recent years, many Muslim officers have continued serving in Indian army at all levels. For example Idris Hassan Latif rose to the position of Air Chief Marshal, later served as Governor of Maharashtra and Ambassador to France. Brigadier Usman gave his life fighting in Kashmir and it was his effort at Uri that the invaders couldn't get

### LOVE JIHAD: A COMPLETE FICTION

The term 'Love Jihad' refers to an 'Ramesh Jihad' which came into light in 2007 in Kerala and Karnataka state, but became part of public discourse in 2009 when Catholic Church bodies in Kerala and Hindu groups in Karnataka claimed that thousands of women had been converted or lured into converting to Islam. In response to the claim, Kerala High Court ordered the police to look into the matter in which a report was submitted which categorically rejected the claim mentioning that there was "no substance" to the claims that "Love Jihad" was taking place. However, in the same year a case of 10-year-old Silja Raj, who eloped with her Muslim boyfriend in Karnataka, was used as propaganda by far-right Hindu groups to peddle the "Love Jihad" myth.

According to Charu Gupta, a professor of history at the University of Delhi, "There is nothing which can prove that 'Love Jihad' actually exists. It is only a way to control women and to build up the bogeyman of evil Muslims," which is evident when the term was widely used by the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) during elections in Uttar Pradesh with the sole purpose to the polarization of the electorate along religious lines. Similar tactics were used by far-right groups when India was still under British rule.

It is significant to note that in certain ways "Love Jihad" along with various issues had an uncanny resemblance to the 'abduction' and conversion campaigns launched by the Arya Samaj and other Hindu revivalist bodies in the 1920s in Uttar Pradesh, at a time when there was a spate of Hindu-Muslim riots in the region. It is also true that in the "Love Jihad" myth lecherous behaviour, skill in luring Hindu women through false promises, a high sexual appetite, a life of luxury and religious fanaticism are all portrayed as dominant traits of the male Muslim character because it provides privileged status to moral panic and public morality over constitutional morality.



Hijab and Quranic Psychology

Recently, Times of India published a story about Haleema Sadiya, a Hijabs Calligraphic performer. Social Media remained on fire, sympathizing with poor Muslim Women, who liberals feel, are oppressed by Islam since centuries. In another remarkable instance, new recruit police Constable Zeena Ali has become New Zealand first member to wear a specially designed hijab as part of her uniform. Contrary to Modern Muslim women reject impermissible veiling and sympathy of all sorts, Islam and Quran have empowered us 1400 years back and Women only need to find out their rights and assert them.

However, the effect of wearing the hijab on the perception of Muslim women within a Muslim country is far from understood. Of particular importance is that the hijab is worn as a symbol of cultural identity, piety, and modesty, and Muslim women within a Muslim country are encouraged to wear this head-covering when in public as a means of limiting their physical attractiveness to men. Indeed, the way in which a woman wears a hijab is widely regarded as a public display of the depth of her faith and the extent to which she is intending to restrict her attractiveness. But despite these intentions, the effect of the hijab on how others perceive the facial attractiveness of the person wearing this item remains to be fully determined.

Most non-Muslims fail to understand that females taking up hijab nowadays are the educated lot who no longer can be told what to wear. And the head gear is neither just about to assert their Islamic identity, it's about Psyche and difference in behavioural patterns of the two sexes which Quran explains very well.
