RESEARCH & PROJECT WORK


- IMPAR in collaboration with Indian Institute of Natural Resources Management has submitted a Project Proposal on Madarsa Transformation of UP, India to NORAD. The entire project proposal is devoted for the benefits of minorities' community. The proposed endeavour is to carefully select only those Madarsas which represents people from all section of societies. It is evident from available structure of Madarsas that majority of students, teachers supporting staffs belongs to vulnerable section of the community which also include PWD, LGBT and elderly people who are the major stakeholders of any such Madarsa. The project implementation will be done taking care of right amalgamation of different sections of vulnerable minorities.
- Project report is prepared for setting up the Community Information and Facilitation Centre (CIFC) at district headquarters under IMPAR District Councils. The CIFC will act as single window for Information, Communication, Education and Facilitation on the documentation required for establishing citizenship, accessing government welfare programs, government subsidy for small businesses/ artisans/ farmers, and access to quality educational institutions. Apart from this, CIFC will also other services which are available through e-governance portal.
- Project report is prepared for creating an economic ecosystem at district level which connects all the stakeholders and serve the service seekers and service providers at the local level. This aims to create a robust, efficient, and cost- effective supply chain to service the businesses at district level, which is essential to generate optimum economic activities and provide jobs or business opportunities for local people. This is done by understanding the input—material or services—needed in the district and creating a platform to get those inputs from the vendors within or outside the district. The Hubs at district level—along with a nerve centre—in harmony with each other, will help in the economic growth and prosperity at grassroot level and help the community become a contributor of Atmnirbhar Bharat with a 5 Trillion US Dollar economy.
- Work on creating a directory of community members from different professional domains started. This will create a network from grassroot to national level and help people access the expertise needed easily from and across the country.
- Work started on preparation of Information booklet for different laws which may impact the life, liberty, or socio-economic well-being of the members of community. This will create much needed awareness among the community about the unintended consequences of their actions and available legal remedy to come out of difficult situation.
