



MANAGING MUSLIM AFFAIRS BY OBJECTIVES AND NOT BY ODDS



10 JULY, 2021 I NEW DELHI

"On the eve of the completion of 15 months of IMPAR"

The popular theory at business schools and in books of management is MBO, Management by Objectives. Those of us who have either studied management or had careers in the corporate would be comfortable with this theory, and often putting it to practice. This theory means that we set forth our objectives and accordingly plan our strategy, organization, human resource, and finances. This makes monitoring effective, midcourse corrections possible and objectives well achievable. While in businesses the success depends more on internal factors of products and technologies, organization and strategies, and HR and investments, but in the social and political spectrum, it is predominantly the external factors that influence the outcomes. However, neither in business organizations the role of external factors nor in social organizations the role of internal factors can be downplayed. In fact, both need to be Managed by Objectives.

Unfortunately, however, my observations of the last 17 years of engagement with the community affairs and off and on with the political system and parties till 2015, when I moved away from political roles, one remarkable difference I could observe, has been the response to situations and developments by the educated and elite of our community and the other communities. The responses by our community have almost always been driven by odds and not by evens. To make difference to the prevailing situation or to any specific situation, it firstly requires an objective analysis and then defining effective interventions for a sustainable solution. This may, at times, require looking for out-of-box thinking and new ways, rather than treading the beaten paths, which could only repeat its promise of assured failures. But, why have I chosen to write on this subject now is the recent context of RSS chief speaking on a book release function about the shared social ethos and spiritual values and common DNA, thus promising a fresh beginning to the Hindu-Muslim relationship? But, while the RSS chief spoke from Ghaziabad, the one corner of the NCR, on the same day, July 5, and maybe around the same time, from Gurgaon, the other corner of NCR, a fringe element in the political setup of Haryana BJP, publicly gave a call of revenge against Muslims.

This sparked off argumentative discussions, whether we should believe what the RSS chief has said or be holding on to our long-held opinions about the rightwing policies and philosophy, given the continuity of venomous rhetoric by such radical vitriolic elements, notwithstanding the historic speech of Mr. Mohan Bhagwat? In my opinion, the Muslim community must grab the opportunity of a new deal in Hindu Muslim relationships, even if it sees little lack of sincerity. The speech of Mr. Mohan Bhagwat is bound to have the positive and neutralizing effect, sooner than later, on such hate-driven publicity-seeking fringe elements. They should be seen as odd elements to derail anything good, and we must go by objectives, and not let them succeed. The change that follows will surely be for good to the community and the nation. Fortunately, by and large, the majority of both, Hindu and Muslim communities have responded positively, however, the radical elements in both sides, as expected, have commented harshly. In fact, surprisingly, the fringe elements in the rightwing spectrum have gone overboard, more than Muslims, to criticize Mr. Bhagwat for his Muslim outreach. The response of the Muslim community has been quite positive in recent years on a number of issues, including the above one. While we should put our trust in hopes of a better social atmosphere, but action against such elements by way of multi-location FIRs is also needed. IMPAR has filed one. Its members may file more.

Overall, this is sure, a hugely welcome change from our earlier behavior and responses, where we necessarily chose odds over even and pursued a reactionary course in complete contrast to the prudent objectives of taking a broader view for sustained interfaith dialogues and promoting understanding and dialogue over deadlock. In fact, our responses, spurted by emotional speeches and short-sighted or agendadriven calls by clergy and political workers, have inevitably been strengthening the right-wing politics and policies. This time, the welcome change has been possible by the demographic change in the community's participation, where women and youth have started playing important roles in social and political matters, whose thinking is more solutions-oriented and practical, than rhetoric and emotional. Their priorities are clear; creating better social understanding, accessing more economic opportunities, and building a shared future. They are no longer driven by the interest-seeking clergy and petty political leaders, mastering emotional speeches and rhetoric, and attempting to drive the community to their political interests and sects. On a happy note, I see our youth as quite practical, and at the same time truly religious and also increasingly committed to the cause of the community. I trust this welcome change will bring about much-needed reforms in the community, and empower it to progress and prosper, sustainably.



इंडियन मुस्लिम्स फॉर प्रोग्रेस एंड रिफॉर्म्स

बिजनेस स्कूलों और प्रबंधन की किताबों में लोकप्रिय सिद्धांत एमबीओ, यानी उद्देश्यों द्वारा प्रबंधन है। हममें से जिन्होंने या तो प्रबंधन का अध्ययन किया है या कॉरपोरेट क्षेत्र में नौकरी की है, वे इस सिद्धांत के साथ सहज होंगे, और अक्सर इसे व्यवहार में लाते रहे होंगे। इस सिद्धांत का अर्थ है कि हम अपने उद्देश्यों को निर्धारित करते हैं और तदनुसार अपनी रणनीति, संगठन, मानव संसाधन और वित्त की योजना बनाते हैं। यह निगरानी को प्रभावी बनाता है, मध्यानवी सुधार संभव बनाता है और उद्देश्यों को अच्छी तरह से प्राप्त करने में सहायक होता है। जबिक व्यवसायों में सफलता उत्पादों और प्रौद्योगिकियों, संगठन और रणनीतियों और मानव संसाधन और निवेश के आंतरिक कारकों पर अधिक निर्भर करती है, लेकिन सामाजिक और राजनीतिक क्षेत्र में मुख्य रूप से बाहरी कारक परिणामों को प्रभावित करते हैं। हालांकि, न तो व्यावसायिक संगठनों में बाहरी कारकों की भूमिका और न ही सामाजिक संगठनों में आंतरिक कारकों की भूमिका को कम करके आंका जा सकता है। वास्तव में, दोनों को उद्देश्यों द्वारा प्रबंधित करने की आवश्यकता है।

दुर्भाग्य से पिछले १७ वर्षों के सामुदायिक मामलों और राजनीतिक व्यवस्था और पार्टियों के साथ २०१५ तक जुड़ाव के मेरे अवलोकन में एक उल्लेखनीय अंतर जो मैं देख सकता था, वह है स्थितियों की प्रतिक्रिया और हमारे समुदाय और अन्य समुदायों के शिक्षित वर्ग द्वारा अलग प्रकार के नजरिया का अपनाया जाना। हमारे समुदाय की प्रतिक्रियाएं लगभग हमेशा विषमताओं से प्रेरित होती हैं न कि सम से। मौजूदा स्थिति या किसी विशिष्ट स्थिति में अंतर लाने के लिए, पहले एक वस्तुनिष्ठ विश्लेषण की आवश्यकता होती है और फिर स्थायी समाधान के लिए प्रभावी हस्तक्षेप को परिभाषित करना होता है। इसके लिए, कभी-कभी, लीक से हटकर सोचने और नए तरीकों की तलाश करने की आवश्यकता हो सकती है, ना की पूराने रास्तों पर चलना, जो केवल सुनिश्चित विफलताओं के अपने वादे को दोहरा सकता है। लेकिन, मैंने अब इस विषय पर लिखने के लिए क्यों चुना है, इसका कारण अभी हाल ही में आरएसएस प्रमुख द्वारा साझा सामाजिक लोकाचार और एकरूप डीएनए के बारे में एक पुस्तक विमोचन समारोह में बोलने का हालिया संदर्भ है, जो हिंदू मुस्लिम संबंधों की एक नई शुरुआत का वादा करता है? लेकिन, जबकि आरएसएस प्रमुख ने गाजियाबाद से ऐसा कहा, उसी दिन, 5 जुलाई को, और लगभग उसी समय, ५० किलोमीटर दूर गुड़गांव से हरियाणा बीजेपी के एक किनष्ठ राजनीतिक तत्व ने सार्वजनिक रूप से मुसलमानों के खिलाफ बदला लेने का आह्वान किया।

कुल मिलाकर, यह निश्चित रूप से, हमारे पहले के व्यवहार और प्रतिक्रियाओं से एक बेहद स्वागत योग्य बदलाव है, जहां हमने आवश्यक रूप से विषम को सम के ऊपर चुना और एक प्रतिक्रियावादी पाठ्यक्रम का अनुसरण किया, जो निरंतर अंतर-धार्मिक संवादों के लिए व्यापक दृष्टिकोण लेने और आपसी समझ और संवाद को बढ़ावा देने के विवेकपूर्ण उद्देश्यों के विपरीत था। गतिरोध वास्तव में, भावनात्मक भाषणों और धार्मिक व राजनीतिक रहनुमाओं द्वारा अदूरदर्शी या एजेंडा संचालित आह्वानो से प्रेरित हमारी प्रतिक्रियाएं अनिवार्य रूप से दक्षिणपंथी राजनीति और नीतियों को मजबूत करती रही है। इस बार का ब्यवहारिक बदलाव समुदाय की भागीदारी में जनसांख्यिकीय परिवर्तन से संभव हुआ है, जहां महिलाओं और युवाओं ने सामाजिक और राजनीतिक मामलों में महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका निभानी शुरू कर दी है, जिनकी सोच भावनात्मक बयानबाजी की तुलना में अधिक समाधान उन्मुख और व्यावहारिक है। उनकी प्राथमिकताएं स्पष्ट हैं; बेहतर सामाजिक समझ पैदा करना, अधिक आर्थिक अवसरों तक पहुंच बनाना और साझा भविष्य का निर्माण करना। वे अब भावनात्मक भाषणों और बयानबाजी में महारत हासिल करने और समुदाय को अपने राजनीतिक हितों और संप्रदायों की ओर ले जाने वाले मुल्ला और निम्न राजनीतिक नेताओं से प्रेरित नहीं हैं। खुशी की बात यह है कि मैं अपने युवाओं को काफी व्यावहारिक और साथ ही सही मायने में धार्मिक और समुदाय के लिए प्रतिबद्ध भी देखता हूं। मुझे विश्वास है, यह स्वागत योग्य परिवर्तन समुदाय में बहुत आवश्यक सुधार लाएगा, और इसे स्थायी रूप से प्रगति और समृद्धि के लिए सशक्त करेगा।

2. IMPAR DISTRICT COUNCIL MEET


COMMUNICATION WITH THE GOVERNMENT/ORGANIZATIONS:

Letter to the Office of Commissioner of Police, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh

Nearly a month back two videos were widely shared over various social media groups. Wherein, some policemen were mercilessly beating Muslim children, which was quite disturbing. Hence, IMPAR spoke with the Police Commissioner, Varanasi, and sent an email. With respect to the other video, we spoke to the Superintendent of Police of the neighboring Mau district. Resultantly, the Superintendent of Police took instant action against the erring policemen, while the Varanasi Police Commissioner set up a DCP level inquiry. Thereafter, on July 02, 2021, IMPAR received a ten-page report by the Commissioner on the setting up of an inquiry and action taken by the Varanasi police.

Henceforth, I believe that if monitoring and timely action are initiated on such matters, the administration is bound to act. To effectively handle such cases, we are considering setting up an "Emergency Monitoring and Response System" under IMPAR. I Hope, this will serve the purpose.






Interactive Session





International Plastic Bag Free Day



Circulating Videos of atrocities

I am seeing lots of news and videos of negative content circulating on social media, seeking action. These videos are often quite disturbing, and sometimes fake. Let me request members, to please:

- 1. Look for organizing local-level action, rather than liberally circulating these videos. The phone numbers and mail IDs of all police officers from SHO to DGP are available online. Even if an online complaint is done some action is likely to be taken.
- 2. Please do not give a communal angle to any criminal incident. This deprives the natural justice to the victim and wastes an enormous amount of community energy and creates negativity and regression in thinking and a feeling of helplessness, which must be avoided at any costs.
- **3.** When we attempt to give it communal color and publicly mobilize support for victims, the aggressors get ten times more support from other groups, like what happened in the case of an incident at Mewat. An honor killing was unnecessarily given communal color by us at a huge cost to the community.
- **4.** There may not be an increase in such incidents as far statistics go, but social media today has made it possible to deliver it to everyone. Better to organize local-level action. And if not possible then please take up with with us directly.
- **5.** Like yesterday one video was circulating, we took up with the SSP Moradabad and there was an immediate response. I hope we as a community become more action-oriented to make a positive difference to the situation on the ground?
