




COMMUNICATION WITH THE GOVERNMENT AGENCIES /ORGANIZATION



IMPAR Letter to Sh. Mohan Bhagwat ji

Sir, let me put on record our deep appreciation for your very positive and bold messages and extremely constructive role in bringing the communities together for peace and prosperity of our country. We may however, wish to draw your kind attention to your recent statement at a function in Mumbai that Islam came to India through invaders. I wish to submit a different historical facts about the advent of Islam in India. As we know Islam came to South India (Kerala) almost 400 years before in 629 AC, whereas the first reported invasion in North India took place in 1002 AC. And the first masjid outside the Arab land was also built in 630 AC in Kerala. The historical records of the world are contained not only in the newly published books in India, but they are present in a much voluminous quantity all over the world in libraries, universities, personal collections, bookstores, as well as on the worldwide web.

Even before the advent of Islam in India or Arabia, the Arab traders had been coming to the coastal regions of south India for trade. They used to buy pepper, cinnamon, and cassia in exchange for dates and olive oil. It was in 629 C.E that Malik Deenar, an associate of the companions of the Prophet came to Kerala with the message of Islam. The Chera King of Kerala heard him and on his instructions, the first mosque was built in Mithala, Kodungullar district, Kerala. That mosque stands there till today, though it was desecrated by the Portuguese in 1504 and then rebuilt. It is pertinent to note that the king, Cheraman Perumal, had also accepted Islam, and that mosque is today known as Cheraman Juma Masjid.

The conversions that took place were the result of the spread of the message of Islam through Sufi saints. Sir, the Indian peninsula has a chequered history that is so unique that it was marvelled upon globally, generating a great impetus to tourism. Nowhere in the world can a tourist witness the hustle bustle of Jama Masjid, the grandeur of Taj Mahal, the abounding history of Fatehpur Sikri, and then travel to Mathura to get coloured by the spirit of Holi, and move further to the *ghats* of Banaras to witness the *arti* from a boat. These are the stories that are talked about all over the world, which should bring people closer, rather creating dissension, discord and disagreements.

Let me again put our appreciation for your kind efforts in promoting peace and understanding in the society, and emphasise that at the sunset of our respective lives, let us please resolve to put an end to all disputes for the sake of leaving behind a platform upon which the next generation gets the chance to live in peace and harmony.





IMPAR Press Release regarding the immediate release of Islamic Scholar Maulana Kaleem Siddiqui from judicial custody SEPTEMBER 22, 2021

The sudden arrest of noted Islamic Scholar Maulana Kaleem Siddiqui, (a resident of Muzaffarnagar, s/o- Late Haji Ameen) by Uttar Pradesh Anti-Terrorist Squad on Tuesday, 21 September (Tuesday) from Meerut can be observed as an effort of promoting enmity on the ground of religion against the entire Indian Muslim community. A person of such a scholarly status cannot be perceived as a danger in the maintenance of public order and prejudicial to the security of the State. The allegations of UP ATS that Jamia Imam Waliullah Trust -run by Maulana Kaleem Siddiqui- that funds several madrassas for which he received huge foreign funding seems baseless and politically motivated.

The arrest of Islamic Scholar Maulana Kaleem Siddiqui on charges of alleged religious conversions seems to be a political vendetta with a vested interest, that can also be observed as a violation of Article 26 of the Constitution of India which ensures the right to manage religious institutions, religious affairs, subject to public order, morality, and health. Moreover, Article 15 of the Constitution of India prohibits discrimination on the grounds of religion, race, caste, sex, and place of birth. Furthermore, Article 25 of the Constitution of India ensures freedom of conscience and the right to freely profess, practice, and propagate religion.

In the given contexts, IMPAR reiterates that if there has to be any religious conversion, then the name of any specific community should not be attached to it without an unbiased investigation. Some great names of Islamic Scholars have been grossly misused over the time by vested interests who want to tarnish the image of Islam and Muslims. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, IMPAR humbly seeks the immediate release of Islamic Scholar Maulana Kaleem Siddiqui from judicial custody.

IMPAR Press Release related to the killing of two civilians in Darrang District of Assam SEPTEMBER 25, 2021

The killing of two civilians during an eviction drive on September 23, 2021 (Thursday) in Dholpur, Darrang District of Assam ought to be condemned in the strongest of terms. As the whole incident captured on camera clearly broadcasts, the policemen armed with guns and sticks are chasing, attacking, and firing gunshots at the protestors, resulting in the brutal killing of teenager, Shakh Farid, and Moinul Haque, one of those who tried to resist eviction.

After collecting his Aadhaar card from the local post office, Shakh Farid was on his way home when he was caught in the brawl. He stood there as a bystander on the protester's side and was hit by a bullet when police opened fire. A bullet hit him in the chest and he died on the spot. The other person killed in the violence was Moinul Haque. Videos showed that he was charging at the police with a stick when he was savagely attacked at Dholpur village and was thrashed, shot and stomped upon to death by the police. In horrifying visuals, as he lay motionless on the ground, Bijoy Bonia, the cameraman kept attacking him until he was restrained. The police have arrested the cameraman. It is reported that Nadeem, one of the injured in the police firing, has also succumbed to his injuries.

This gruesome act of the killing of Farid Shakh, Moinul Haque, and Nadeem has badly shaken the confidence and social equilibrium of Indian society and has placed the minority's security concern at great risk in Assam. Moreover, the modus operandi of the police personnel has been severely dented by such a warlike activity.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, IMPAR, in the larger interest of minority's security, humbly sought the kind intervention of the government of Assam, and the Ministry of Home Affairs, and demanded the immediate suspension of the policemen and SSP till the release of the report of the judicial commission, which should investigate the role of the policemen and SSP. Moreover, IMPAR demanded compensation of 1 crore each to the families of Shakh Farid, Moinul Haque, and Nadeem.


Hindi Diwas



World Peace Day


On September 21, 2021, IMPAR observed the International Day of Peace.




Birthday Wishes to former Prime Minister, Dr Manmohan Singh


Tribute To Bhagat Singh


Tribute To the Father of the Nation Mahatma Gandhi




