IMPAR has delivered on all key challenges since its formation, and hopes to further accelerate its pace of delivery and performance.

I am confident IMPAR over the years will develop into a powerful institution to steer the community towards the path of progress and reforms, and help to usher in an era of peace and prosperity across our country.
