Interaction with Shri Suresh Prabhu, MP and PM's Sherpa for G7 and G 20 countries

IMPAR organised an interaction with Shri Suresh Prabhu, Member Parliament and Prime Minister's Sherpa for G7 and G 20 countries.

In his interaction with IMPAR members, Mr Suresh Prabhu emphasised that Development, Reforms and Progress are the need of the hour. He strived that as Indians we have a shared destiny and we share similar challenges too. In this case, *Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas* and *Sabka Vishwas* is the only philosophy that will bind everyone together.

Mr Prabhu's focus throughout the interaction was on how Indians should live a life of dignity through economic activities. He specifically discussed the historical role of artisans and how they have always been responsible for bringing prosperity.
